

Reporting Students with Disabilities

Definitions

The Civil Rights Data Collection (CRDC) collects information on students with disabilities in **two** different categories. The table below shows the definitions of the two categories that appear in the CRDC survey tables.

<p>Students with Disabilities (IDEA)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students with intellectual disabilities; hearing impairment, including deafness; speech or language impairment; visual impairment, including blindness; serious emotional disturbance; orthopedic impairment; autism; traumatic brain injury; developmental delay; other health impairment; specific learning disability; deaf-blindness; or multiple disabilities and who, by reason thereof, receive special education and related services under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) according to an Individualized Education Plan, Individual Family Service Plan, or service plan. • The Students with Disabilities (IDEA) column in the survey items always refers to students with disabilities who receive special education and related services under IDEA. • Student may or may not also be served under Section 504.
<p>Students with Disabilities (Section 504 Only)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students with a disability who receive regular or special education and related aids and services solely under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (as amended), and not under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA). • The Section 504 only column in the survey items always refers to students with disabilities who receive regular or special education and related aids and services under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, and NOT under IDEA.
<p>Examples of accommodations in 504 plans include:</p>	
<p>Preferential seating Extended time on tests and assignments Reduced homework or classwork Verbal, visual, or technology aids Modified textbooks or audio-video materials excused lateness, absence, or missed classwork</p>	<p>Behavior management support Adjusted class schedules or grading Verbal testing Pre-approved nurse's office visits and accompaniment to visits Occupational or physical therapy</p>

Reporting Students

In most CRDC survey tables, All Students will be counted in the seven race and ethnicity categories.

All Students refers to students without disabilities, students with disabilities served under IDEA, and students with disabilities served under Section 504 only.

There are instances in which a separate count, a subset, is collected on students with disabilities only. The table will typically have a **Students with Disabilities (IDEA)** column, a **Students with Disabilities (Section 504 Only)** column, or both. The table below summarizes table types and considerations for reporting students with disabilities. These points are described in more detail in the following pages.

Table Type	How to Report Students with Disabilities
Two columns for students with disabilities	IDEA and Section 504 are separate, non-overlapping counts
One column for students with disabilities	Students with disabilities served under IDEA in the Students with Disabilities (IDEA) column. These students may or may not also be served under Section 504.

Tables that have Two Columns for Students with Disabilities (IDEA and Section 504 Only)

When a table for a survey item requires counts for both categories of students, please note that these are separate, non-overlapping counts. Refer to the graphic/table below to ensure that student counts are entered correctly.

- Students with disabilities served under Section 504 Only should not be included in the **Students with Disabilities (IDEA)** column of the table.
- If students are served under both IDEA and Section 504, then those students should be counted under the Students with Disabilities (IDEA) column only.

Tables That Only Have a Column for Students with Disabilities (IDEA)

For a table that collects separate counts for **Students with Disabilities (IDEA)** but does not have a category for **Students with Disabilities (Section 504 Only)**, include:

- All students in the **Race/Ethnicity** and **Total** columns; and
- Students with disabilities served under **IDEA in the Students with Disabilities (IDEA)** column. These students may or may not also be served under Section 504
- Students with disabilities served under Section 504

“All students” refers to students without disabilities, students with disabilities served under IDEA, and students with disabilities served under Section 504 Only.

Tables for Students with Disabilities Only

- If a table collects counts for students with disabilities only, then include counts of students with disabilities served under IDEA in the **IDEA** columns and counts of students with disabilities served under Section 504 only in the **Students with Disabilities (Section 504 Only)** column.
- The **EL Students with Disabilities** column may include counts of EL students with disabilities served under IDEA and counts of EL students with disabilities served under Section 504 only.

Tables for Students Without Disabilities Only

- If a table collects counts for students without disabilities only, exclude counts of students with disabilities served under IDEA or counts of students with disabilities served under Section 504 Only.
- If a table collects counts for non-IDEA students only, then include students without disabilities and students with disabilities served only under Section 504 in the non-IDEA counts.
